


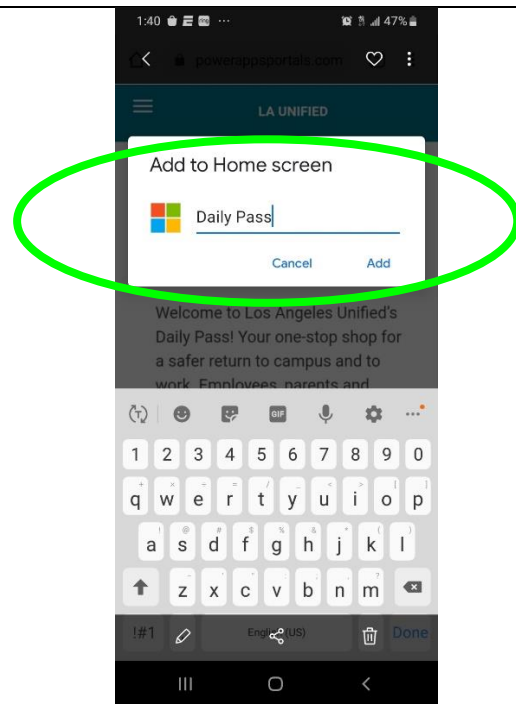


Creating a Daily Pass Shortcut on your iPhone
